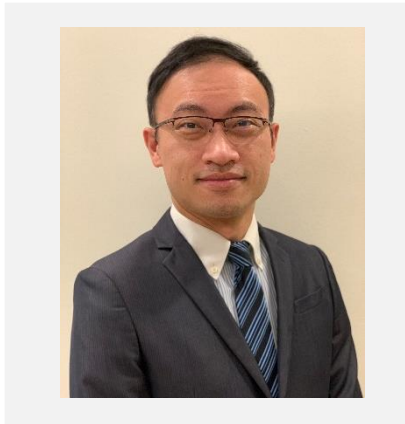


Dr. Junxiong Vincent Pang

Dr. Pang is an epidemiologist focusing on the epidemiology, surveillance and prevention of global infectious diseases threat in particularly zoonotic diseases. Dr. Pang had served as a consultant to the World Health Organization (WHO) MERS-CoV Epidemiology Workgroup in Geneva, Switzerland, and the Ministry of Health (MOH) COVID-19 Epidemiology Workgroup in Singapore. Dr. Pang's public health expertise also involves pandemic preparedness and outbreak management. Dr. Pang was Deputy Director and then Director for Centre for Infectious

Disease Epidemiology and Research in Saw Swee Hock School of Public Health in National University of Singapore, leading a multi-disciplinary team to strengthen infectious disease surveillance, risk assessment, research and outbreak investigations. Dr. Pang had also served as a consultant to the WHO Indonesia, South-East Asia and Western Pacific Offices, the Ministry of Manpower (Singapore) ACE Medical Unit and the Singapore Armed Forces Biodefence Unit on pandemic preparedness and outbreak management.
