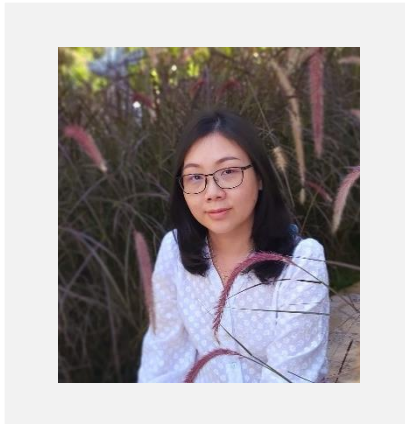


Dr. Yin Myo Aye
