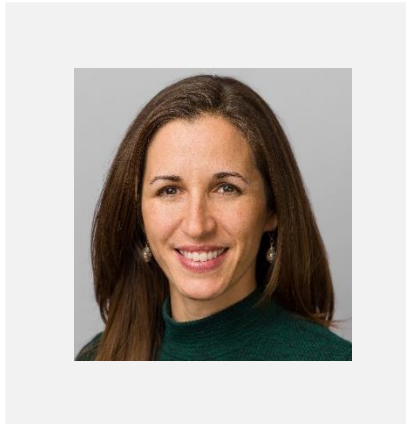


## **Dr. Alexandra Zuber**
